What is the Community Resource Database?

Designed to help refer people to clubs, organizations, human services and special interest groups in the Chester County region. The database includes information submitted to the Library by groups, organizations or individuals associated with those groups or organizations.

How to Find the Index

To Search from the Internet:

- Access the Chester County Library System's Web site, <www.ccls.org>.
- Under **Internet Links**, click on **Databases**.
- Click on **All Databases**.
- Click on **Community Resource Guide**.

- Under **Internet Links**, click on **Regional Information**.
- Click on **Organizations & Volunteer Opportunities**.
- Click on **Community Resource Guide**.

How to Search the Index

Keyword Search:

- Type in one or more words in the **search** box.
- Click the **Search** button.

List All Organizations:

- Click on **organization's name**.

List All Areas of Interest:

- Click on **interest** category.
- Click on an **organization's name**.
