

LEARNING EXPRESS LIBRARY

Learning Express Library (LEL) contains practice tests for academic and professional exams.

There are practice tests for the following academic exams: AP (biology, calculus, English and history), SAT, SAT II, ACT, GED, GMAT, GRE, LSAT, MCAT and TOEFL.

There are practice tests for the following professional exam-types: PRAXIS, civil service, postal worker, cosmetology, ASVAB, EMS, firefighter, real estate and law enforcement.

In addition to the practice tests, there are also skill improvement courses, including elementary and secondary math and writing as well as resume preparation and business writing.

LEL is available at all libraries in the Chester County Library System and from home. You will need a 14-digit Chester County Library System library card for remote access.

- You will need your 14-digit library barcode number to use **LEL** (see next section).

- **To Use LEL:**
- **Click** on the **New User** button.
- Enter a user name and password. **From home, the user name will need to be your library card barcode.**
- Choose a practice test or online skills course.
- **Click** on the title of the practice test to get a description or **click** on the **Practice New** button to get started

Please note: Signing in to **LEL** allows you to work on practice tests at your own speed. You can log back in using the same user name and password and continue where you left off.
